1. Find foster care organization near you and email them

2. Complete and email both completed forms below to shelby@teamcelebrate.org. Wait for a confirmation email.

3. Start a Fundraiser

Easy Rules

- Must make a minimum of 4 boxes (gender neutral or even split between boy/girl themes)
- Everything must be new and kept in original packaging
- Must buy enough supplies for 8 party guests
- Feel free to include more than what is listed above...the list is just the minimum
- All supplies must go together (ex: please don't include superhero plates with princess napkins)
- Please don't mention anything about being in foster care, family or religion in the cards, instead include a positive birthday message and sign your first name
